**Act now:**  
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Egg-laying quail in live market battery cages are not protected by Prop 12. It's not just *how* they die. It's the *cruelty before* slaughter. Quail act as an intermediate host of viruses between waterbirds like ducks, and domestic chickens. All three are found in LA markets.
