SENATORS OF THE YEAR

Ellen Corbett, Ted Lieu, Christine Kehoe, Joe Simitian

AB 298 by Assemblymember Julia Brownley re: Plastic Bags. Support. Failed.
Would have phased out one time use plastic bags.

AB 2179 by Assemblymember Michael Allen re: Wildlife. Support. Failed.
Simplifies enforcement of Fish & Game Code violations.

AB 2283 by Assemblymember Tony Portantino re: Wildlife. Support. Failed.
Would have renamed Department of Fish & Game to Fish & Wildlife.

AB 2402 by Assemblymember Jared Huffman re: Wildlife. Support. Passed.
Renames Department of Fish & Game to Fish & Wildlife and sets up an independent scientific advisory panel.

AB 2609 by Assemblymember Ben Hueso re: Fish & Game Commission. Support. Passed.

Establishes qualifications for Fish & Game Commissioners and requires them to adopt a code of conduct.

SB 969 by Senator Juan Vargas re: Groomers. Support. Failed.

Would have set up a voluntary certification program for groomers.

SB 1066 by Senator Ted Lieu re: Global Warming. Support. Passed.

Authorizes the State Coastal Conservancy to address impacts of global warming.

SB 1221 by Senator Ted Lieu re: Bears/Bobcats. Support. Passed.

Prohibits the hunting of bear and bobcats with hounds.

SB 1480 by Senator Ellen Corbett re: Trapping. Support. Vetoed.

Would have established a trapping license for those who trap animals considered doing damage. Would have prohibited cruel methods of killing.
